**Criteria:**

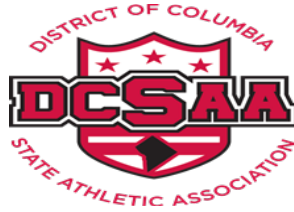
1. Applicant must demonstrate the following:
  - A. Earned a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average;
  - B. Earned a letter in a Varsity sport for at least two years;
  - C. Acceptance to an accredited college/university or trade school with enrollment on a full-time basis beginning no later than January 2019;
2. Applicant must complete and submit attached scholarship application, along with supporting materials, no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2018.
3. Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from high school teacher, guidance counselor, or administrator.
4. Applicant's high school principal and athletic director must sign the application to ensure that the academic and athletic information submitted is accurate.

Applicant must attend a member school of the District of Columbia Athletic Association and be in compliance with all rules and regulations set forth in 5 DCMR A § 5001.1 and those governing eligible non-residents.

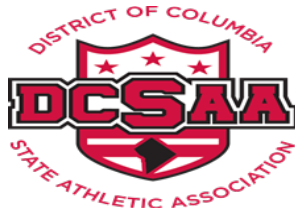

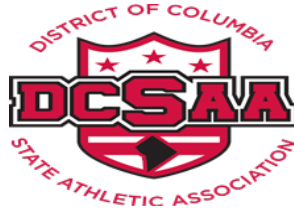

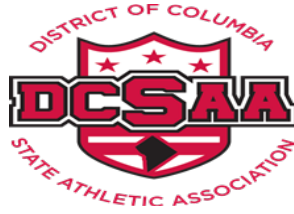
### Payment of Scholarship Funds:

1. In order for scholarship funds to be provided directly to the accredited college/university or trade school, the following documents must be provided to the D.C. State Athletic Association no later than December 1, 2018:
  - A. **An official copy from the Registrar's Office indicating enrollment and number of credit hours.**
  - B. **An official copy from the Finance Office of the student's bill.**
2. All scholarship funds will be applied directly to student accounts to cover tuition, room and board, and books at an accredited college/university or trade school. No funds will be disbursed to students or families.
3. ***All scholarship funds not claimed by 4:00 p.m., December 1, 2018 will be forfeited.***
